GPA / percentage is meaningful indication of the applicant's academic ability and stability to AUM programs. The College of Business is open for both Arts and Science Majors and requires the following minimum GPA:

- **General Government High School System: 60%**
- **American-based High School Diploma: 2.0**

B. English Language Skills Assessment:

The AUM's curriculum uses the English language as the sole instruction medium. That is why the AUM makes sure that its prospective students have the English language proficiency needed to guarantee their success in the college. The English language skills are tested through the English Language Test, an internet based test, which assesses a student's skill in Listening, Reading and Grammar in English.

Applicants must achieve a minimum score of Level 1 in the AUM English Language Test.

C. Math Skills Assessment:

Applicants to the Business program at AUM must demonstrate knowledge of basic mathematical skills in pre-algebra that would guarantee their success and suitability to the program. This is done through the AUM Math Test which is a comprehensive, multiple choice, and computer-based exam.

Applicants must achieve a minimum score of 40% in the AUM math test.

D. Written Communication Skills Assessment:

Written communication skills are determined through the assessment of a written essay. Therefore, applicants are required to write a personal essay from a set of topics. The essay tests the applicant's ability to explain information using clear and simple language and to present information and data to others in an understandable manner.

Applicants must achieve minimum score of 60% in the written communication skills, also applicants have the option to write there essay in English or Arabic.

- c. 5.5 or above on the Academic IELTS.

3. Minimum 65% or above on the AUM Math Assessment test.
